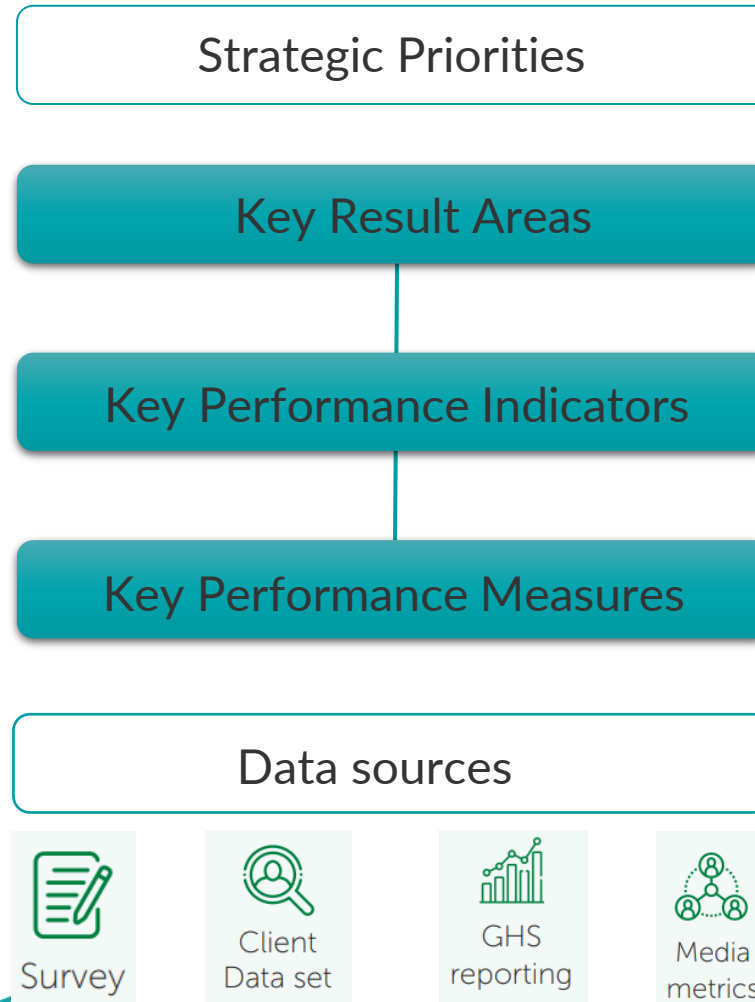

1. Develop a **communications strategy** and deliver the first phase of a **multi-year community education campaign**

1. Deliver an accreditation program for amateur clubs to create safer sporting environments (**Here For The Game**)
2. Trial a community-based, pro-social **alternative** to gambling program

1. Develop resources and support for **loved ones** as allies in care
2. Break down **barriers to risky gamblers** accessing treatment
